- Meeting called to order.
- Introductions
- Public Comment - no members of the public present. Michael Lewis asks a question about recent press article regarding cameras at the new Pulse stations, expressing concerns about privacy. GRTC responds that they take privacy seriously and the cameras at the Pulse stations are governed by the same privacy policy used for cameras on-board busses.
- Approval of Jan 18th, 2018 meeting minutes tabled as no minutes were written
- GRTC showed a slide presentation of the design of their new mobile application
- GRTC provided an update that the Pulse project was going well and that a date would soon be set for launch.
- GRTC described and asked for help recruiting for a volunteer program to help convert route number signage prior the network changes.
- GRTC solicited feedback on several ways to layout printed schedules for frequent routes with branches (the 1A,1B,1C). No consensus was reached.
