Minimum Criteria
Response Timeliness: RFP response is submitted by the due date and time.
Response Authorization: The RFP response contains an original signature signed by a company officer on the Proposal Signature Form.
Response Completeness: Vendor complied with all instructions in the RFP and provided a response to all items requested with enough detail, which provides for the proposal to be properly evaluated. Any deficiencies in this regard will be determined by GRTC's Procurement Director to be either a defect that the Director will waive or that the proposal can be sufficiently modified to meet the requirements of the RFP.
Minimum Client Software Installations: Must have provided software for 3 public sector and/or transit organizations of similar size and complexity.

DBE Disclosure: Please note that Collaborative Solutions and iKW submitted the "Section III – DBE Unavailable Certification" noting their efforts to comply with the DBE requirement. Tyler Technologies indicated a DBE partner, but did not provide attached DBE certification. All other vendors indicated successful partnerships with DBE's for the proposal and provided DBE certifications.
