**Presbyterian Homes & Family Services and the Family Alliance Ways to Work:** Funding to support one full time Loan Coordinator, one part-time Data Analyst, loan capital, supplies and borrower incentives. The Ways to Work program provides low interest, character based, direct to consumer auto loans to transportation challenged families.
