

Ticket Vending Machine Reduced Fare

ONE RIDE – REDUCED FARE: The Pulse Ticket Vending Machine offers a reduced fare one ride on the Pulse. This guides you through the screen flow.

When you wake the screen up, you'll see this:



Click on "Buy Other Passes" on the left.

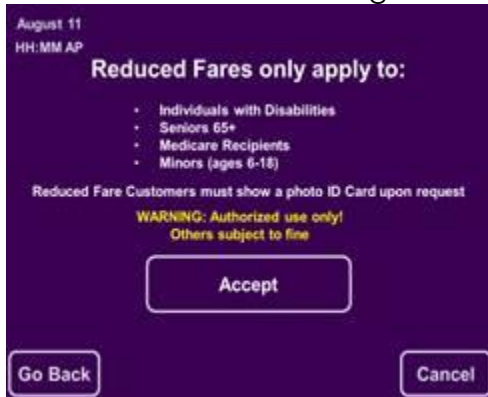
Select "Local" green on this screen:



Select "Pulse 1 Ride Reduced" in the bottom right of the next screen:

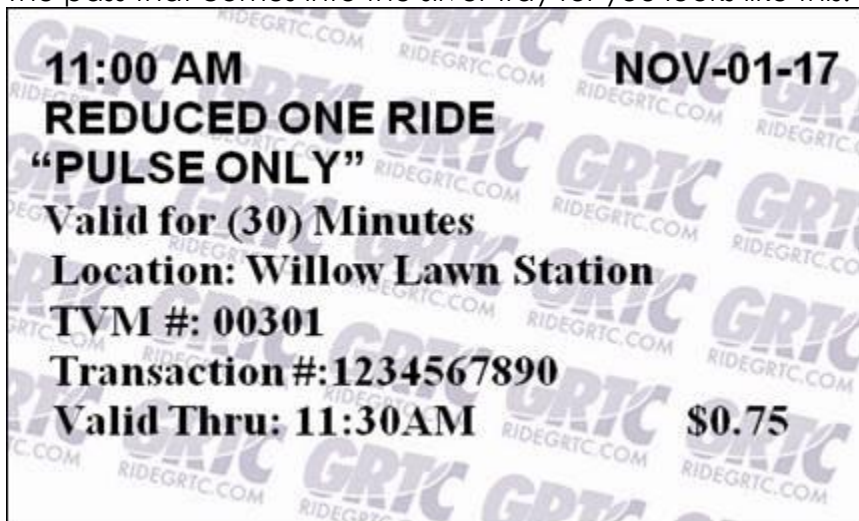


You will next see a warning screen about qualifying for reduced fare. Touch "Accept."



The rest of the screens will prompt you through the payment process by cash/coin or credit/debit.

The pass that comes into the silver tray for you looks like this:



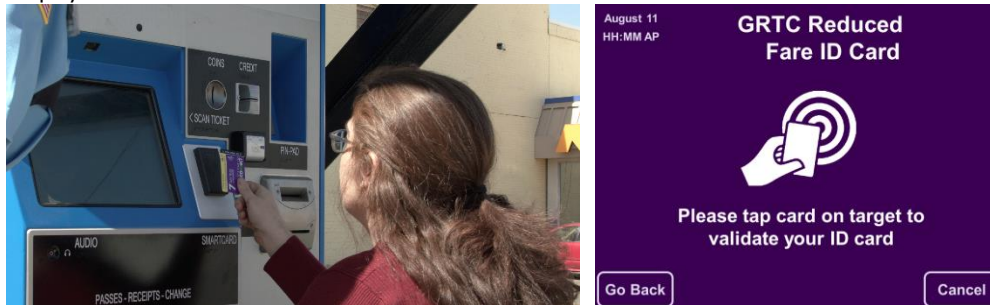
Don't forget to take your pass from the tray, and keep this pass handy for fare inspection.

TWO RIDES ONE-WAY – REDUCED FARE: If you plan to ride the Pulse and another connecting route one-way, then we encourage you to get our free GRTC reduced fare ID, which will open up the free connection (transfer) option on the Pulse Ticket Vending Machine to you.

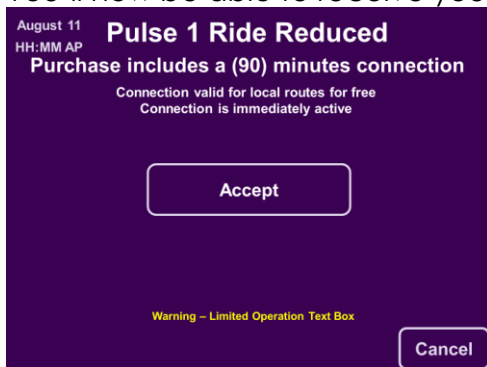
When you're on the start screen, you can select the right button "GRTC Reduced Fare ID Card"



Tap your ID on the smart black reader in the middle of the Ticket Vending Machine.

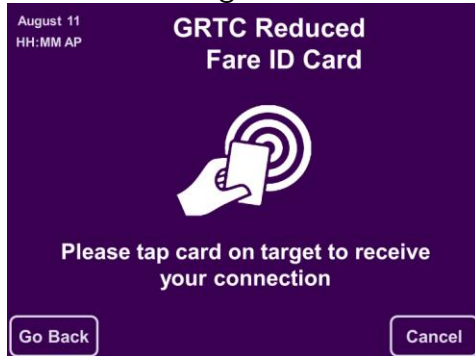


You'll now be able to receive your timed connection (transfer). Touch "Accept."



Follow the payment process.

Before completing your transaction, the machine will prompt you to tap your ID onto to smart reader again to encode the timed connection (transfer) onto the ID card.



When you board another bus, you simply tap your ID on the smart reader and it reads your timed connection.
