Q1

Comments/Feedback on proposed changes to Route 77 (see maps above):

This is a great combination that should provide better service and save money. However, now that you'd be pulling the Grove bus away from Broad, you should go all the way and make the Grove bus an extension of the 5. Make every 4th 5 WB turn right on Malvern, Hamilton or Thompson to Grove and then take this routing to UR (if you choose Thompson, you have to deal with the EB differently due to one-way street, and Nansemond is narrow and doesn't get you to the Kroger stop); I'd probably choose Malvern due to street width, and there is some density at Malvern and Cary. This would allow direct service to downtown without having to transfer for just 3 stops from VCU to downtown, while still providing service to VCU. Alternatively, you could extend the 78 instead of the 5, but the 78 will create a large detour for West End customers, so may as well make this bus the 5B and the short terminating bus at Thompson, the main bus, the 5A.

Also, this eliminates the old, troublesome turn at Libbie/Grove, so no need to relitigate that fight.

Q2

Comments/Feedback on the proposed Route 77 stop locations (see star icons in the above map):

This is fine, but I might move the Stafford stop to Strawberry. Meadow and Lombardy are in the right place, and there shouldn't be any more stops. I still think transferring this route into a long line of the 5 would be better, but if it's to stay on Grove, this is good stop spacing. Note, also, that stop spacing is shorter on Cary/Main, and you should be adjusting the stop spacing there to align with this Grove stop spacing of Lombardy and Meadow.

The 75 will become largely superfluous, so this is a good idea! UR will probably still run a private shuttle to Willow Lawn and the Village shopping area. St. Mary's is still served from elsewhere, and people can walk to Patterson to access those areas.

This is a smart way to continue to cover the hospital and other businesses on Libbie and Patterson. It is not as straight as before, but this coverage bus is fine doing this if it hits your cycle times.

Q5

I don't love this detour to St. Mary's, but I suppose it's necessary. However, I would strongly consider, EB, after stopping at St. Mary's, R from Bremo to Monument and then L on Willow Lawn, rather than going back to Patterson (same for reverse). You also get to serve Weinstein JCC and some other medical offices, and people can walk the at most three blocks on Patterson from Maple to Glenburnie. As well, those Patterson businesses are now served by the new 76 routing, and are probably going to get more bus customers from the City of Richmond part of the West End than from Henrico, where people would probably drive anyway.

Comments/Feedback on proposed changes to Route 50 (see maps above):

Build Pulse stations at Malvern and Lombardy and then eliminate the 50 as soon as the requirement to maintain it from the TIGER grant ends. This could save \$2 million a year in operating costs compared to this routing, and the capital expenditures for a station during the Pulse construction were about half a million a station, so with 4 stations (two locations, one each WB and EB) you could recoup the savings in one year! There are gaps even with this, but you hit the larger dense areas (Kroger, TJ, etc.) and the longest walk, to Westmoreland, is only about 1500 feet, which has very little density to the north and, to the south, after a few blocks people may just walk to Patterson. AND you have the 91 that people can take to Malvern or Willow Lawn for local service. Spending \$2M a year for such few travellers once these stations are built is not the best use of funds, and I'm sure you could use them better elsewhere.

The Lombardy and Meadow Stops are good because they both coincide with Route 5 stop locations on Main and Cary, and they intersect highly-trafficked north/south routes from Randolph through the Fan to Broad Street. I would recommend shifting the Stafford Street stops one block east to Strawberry Street. This would align them with the Route 5 stops at Addison, and would provide a direct north-south route between Byrd Park over the Addison Street overpass to the Fan. In addition, crosswalks at Addison and Cary/Main are signalized, making both streets easier to cross. Stafford is not signalized at ether location and is more difficult to cross.

Consider the origins of riders transferring to the existing Route 75 bound for U of R. Consider a Broad to Roseneath to Leigh to Arthur Ashe Blvd. to Broad routing for WB and opposite for EB. In addition to this change, consider eliminating Route 20's entry into Scotts Addition, instead keeping it on Broad and Boulevard for efficiency and speed.
