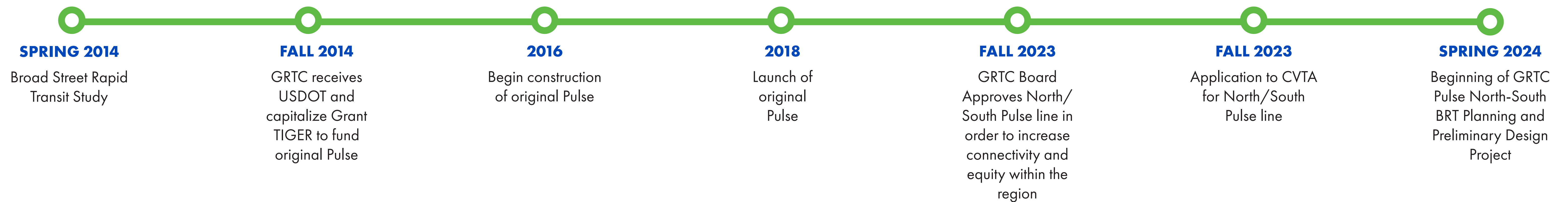




# Project Information

## Project History

The GRTC Pulse has been a part of Richmond for more than 10 years. The timeline below outlines the history of the GRTC Pulse Bus Rapid Transit, and the steps that brought us here today.

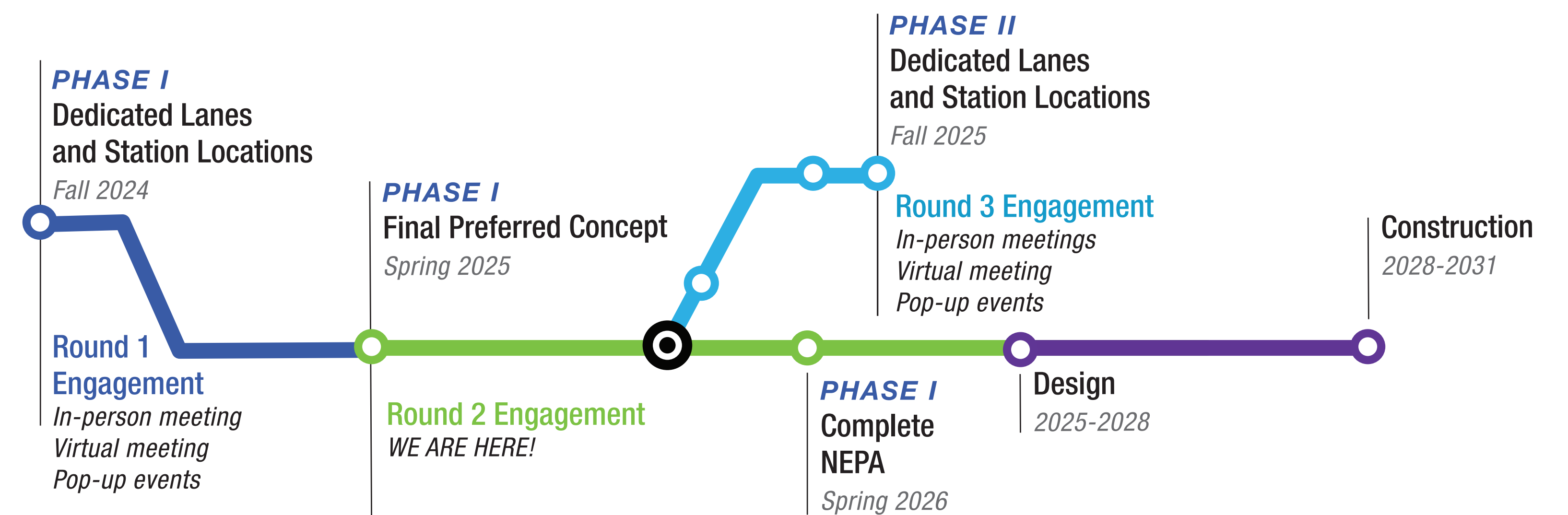


## Project Overview

In Fall 2023, GRTC completed the GRTC Pulse North-South Bus Rapid Transit (BRT) Corridor Study to determine a preferred corridor alignment for a North-South BRT line. The study paired public input with demographics, employment, equity, multimodal, connectivity, and existing transit service. A preferred corridor alignment was selected by GRTC for further design and environmental review.

This project picks up where the 2023 study left off. GRTC Pulse North-South BRT will be constructed in phases. This project will advance Phase I of the locally preferred alternative through conceptual design and the federally-required environmental evaluation process. It will also advance conceptual planning of the segments identified as future phases of the alignment. When this project concludes, Phase I will be eligible to compete for federal funding for detailed design and construction.
